- The show will run online via the COWS website from 11/15/2020 through 12/31/2020
- Juror/Judge is yet to be determined.

- 2. Instead of submitting 3 matted watercolors in-person, you are asked to do the following to complete your submission:
 - a. Take a picture of each of your paintings without a mat
 - b. Create pictures as a .JPG file and make sure each picture is between 1 MB and 3 MB
 - c. You will submit the 3 .JPGs, the application, and the title and size of each painting to COWSWebsite@columbus.rr.com.
- 3. Submission deadline is MONDAY, OCTOBER 12th, 12 midnight.

4. Paintings will be juried the weekend of October 17th. The membership committee chair will notify you of the results.
