It is an honor to welcome Steve Griggs (<a href="https://www.stevegriggswatercolor.com/">https://www.stevegriggswatercolor.com/</a>) as our presenter for our March 14th meeting. He is very highly recommended by our 1st VP, Jeff Stahler. Steve's art career began in elementary school when he received his first set of "real" watercolor paint tubes. ### A few additional notes about the Spring Show at the Cultural Arts Center

The Friends of the Cultural Arts Center will retain 30% of the listed price of all artwork sold during the exhibit. They will collect and pay the applicable sales tax. These pieces will be marked as "sold" while on display. The purchaser will pay by cash, check, or credit card. The Friends of CAC will pay the artist within 30 days after receipt of the full listed price. The artist will receive 70% of the listed retail price and the Friend, 30%. After the close of the exhibition, it is the responsibility of the artist to deliver or ship the purchased work to the buyer.

COWS will provide the Cultural Art Center with a price list for insurance purposes. This will include the value of any painting that is not for sale (NFS). The paintings on display will be insured for \$50,000 total. The coverage applies only during the show not during transport or storage.

And just a reminder – not that we need one – but the pandemic and city/state regulations may affect the running of our show. For example, a reception may be canceled or limited to the number of attendees at a time. More on that as the time approaches.
