Directions to Jim Gerkin's home

Here goes:

From Columbus

- Take Rt 33 toward Lancaster
- Just past Carroll, take the 33 By-Pass (sign will say Logan)
- On the By-Pass go two exits and take the exit for Rt 22
- Go RIGHT on 22 (this will seem wrong because the sign points left to Lancaster)
- Go one mile on Rt 22
- Turn left on Delmont Road (there is a Marathon gas station at this intersection)
- Go about .5 mile (to the top of the hill) and take the left side of a "Y" onto Stoney Hill Road
- Go .8 mile to Hopewell Church Road
- Turn right and drive until you come to a Stop sign (about 1.1 miles), this

ARTICLE VI: Exhibitions, SECTION A. Eligibility, Number 2a

1. Change to "Only transparent watercolor that allows light to be reflected directly only from the white paper may be used as the painting medium. Thus, metallic, iridescent, or any other paint that reflects light from the paint to produce a shimmer effect may not be used. In addition, other water-based media and any white paint may not be used. The paint may be applied directly as it comes from the tube or pan or diluted with water. No other material shall be permanently added to the painting surface or mixed with the watercolor medium, except graphite pencil may be used for the initial structural drawing."

ARTICLE VI: Exhibitions, SECTION B. Disputes

1.Instead of ARTICLE II, SECTION E, correct to read, ARTICLE VI, SECTION E
