The Opening Reception will be on Sunday, November 14th, from 2 p.m. to 4 p.m. at the Meeting Haus. The Opening Reception will be in lieu of our regularly scheduled November COWS meeting.

There has been a change in the entry fees beginning with this Fall Show. By unanimous vote, the Board agreed to charge \$20.00 if you are entering 1 or 2 paintings in the show and \$30.00 if you enter 3 paintings.
