Demonstration: The World Looks Better in Watercolor -- David Rankin "Dazzle"

- Nationally known watercolor landscape and wildlife artist, David Rankin shares a little about his artistic journey. His style is based on what he calls natural abstraction, in which he develops realistic subjects using abstract design principles that he finds in Nature. He credits his time living and traveling in India as a primary inspiration for much of his professional career.
- For his demo, he will paint one of his favorite subjects of the Himalayas, demonstrating procedures he uses to create dramatic visual effects using careful color values, intensities, spatial design and a strict understanding of the 3 planes of illusory depth.
- This demo and discussion will provide a preview of his upcoming 2-1/2 days workshop November 2-4.
