The COWS Open Show will be at the <u>Delaware Arts Castle</u> - Take in end of June. This open show means you can submit 1 to 3 paintings, must be transparent Watercolor, doesn't matter if you showed it before, this show is not juried. Details to follow.

JoAnn Boehm was awarded Best of Show at GAAL annual spring show for transparent watercolor "Winter Reflection." The judge was Suzanne Accetta. The show is at Gahanna City Hall, 1st & 2nd floors from March 1 thru April 30.

Jeff Stahler: Jeff's cartoon art is a part of the current exhibit 'The Force of Fandom' an exhibit that celebrates the way the world's most famous galaxy-spanning odyssey (Star Wars) inspires art at the Columbus Museum of Art thru August 19.

Second Vice president **Jeff Stahler**, taking over for President **Suzanne Accetta** who was out of town, opened the meeting at 2:08 pm with committee reports.

- Sally Ford-Lyles, Workshop and Website chair, reminded everyone that the Summer Show will be in the Delaware Arts Castle (http://artscastle.org/), July 5 to August 10. Take in will be June 24 from 10:00 AM to noon (note: this may change due to a conflict with the German Village Paint Out see below). Artist's reception will be July 8 from 2:00 to 4:00 PM. This is an open show (not juried), and each artist may submit up to 3 paintings. Information about the paintings will need to be submitted before take in. Pictures do not have to be for sale, but, if you do sell a painting, the Arts Castle charges a 30% commission. When you submit your paintings, please have them in a protective box, because they will need to be stored and/or transported prior to the show. Sally will post more information about this show on the website soon.
- **Sally** also reminded everyone that Bill Vrscak, the juror for the **Spring Show**, will be offering a 3-day workshop from May 29 to May 31, 9:30 AM to 4:30 PM.. The venue for this workshop has not been determined, but you can find up-to-date information on the Society website at http://www.centralohiowatercolorsociety.com/workshops.html. Sally will post the registration form on the Society website very soon. If you are interested in attending this workshop, sign up early, because it promises to be very popular. Cost to Society members will be \$170. A non-refundable deposit of \$40 will reserve your place.
- **Sally** also asked members to send her an example picture (jpeg format) of one of their paintings to post on the website. You can update a photo that is currently on the web or add your work to the paintings currently there. When you send her your photo, please also include whatever contact information you'd like listed (e.g., email, website, phone number).
- **Jeff Stahler**, Second Vice President and chair of the **Fall Show**, reported that the show will take place at the German Village Meeting Haus in German Village from November 18 to December 14. Take in will be November 15 or 16 at the Meeting Haus, and take down will be December 14. The German Village Lights evening will be the first Sunday in December (December 2), and we hope to have artists on hand doing demonstrations as we did last year. If you'd like to be one of the demonstrators, contact Jeff.
- **Jeff** also noted that he is taking over from Jim Wiggins as the liaison for the **German Village Paint Out**, which will be the last weekend in June. Vivian Ripley noted that there is a potential conflict between preparation for the Paint Out and take in for the Summer show, so this will need to be resolved. Jeff is on the art committee for German Village, and their first meeting will be tomorrow. He expects there will be some changes from past years in the procedure for the Paint Out, so artists interested in participating should stay tuned!
- Marsha Cavenaugh, First Vice President and chair of the upcoming Spring Show, reminded members that the Spring Show will be June 1 to June 30 at the Westerville

Community Center. Take in will be Friday, June 1, and the opening reception will be Sunday, June 3, from 2:00 to 4:00 PM. Marsha passed around a sign-up sheet for helping with the show. If you can help with take in, hanging, the reception, or anything else, please contact her at marshakcavanaugh@hotmail.com. The juror will be Bill Vrscak (see above). The entry form for the Spring Show is now available on the Society website under "News and Events."

- Pam Hartford, publicity chair, will prepare an e-postcard about the Spring Show that members can send out to their friends. Pam will also look into getting information about the show into the Dispatch, This Week, and social media. Sally Ford-Lyles said she could get the information posted on Arts Alive calendar, if Pam will send her the information. Pam also met with Marsha Cavenaugh and the Spring Show committee. She has prepared a mock-up of a flier for the Spring Show that can be posted in likely places (e.g., arts centers).
- **Kate Hagovsky**, Hospitality Committee, is organizing refreshments for the Spring Show reception. She will prepare a sign-up sheet for volunteers. If you wish to volunteer now, please contact Kate at khagovsky@yahoo.com.

Officer Reports

- Treasurer **Sandy Gaunt** reported that she has received \$500 from the Columbus Foundation for the "Best in Show" award at the last Fall Show, won by **Bess Alexander**. The award is funded by the family of Edward G. and Maxine D Tracy. Sandy also reported that our checking account balance is \$11,069.23 and our savings account balance is \$8,020.96 for a combined total of \$19,090.19.
- Recording Secretary Mitch Masters asked whether there were any corrections or additions to the February minutes. None were offered.

Announcements

- **Jeff Stahler** reminded everyone that the May meeting will be the first Sunday in the month (May 6) rather than the second, due to Mother's Day on May 13.
- **Sandy Gaunt** noted that the Columbus Museum of Art currently has an exhibit in which **Jeff Stahler** has 3 cartoons.
- **Vivian Ripley** reminded everyone that the Art at the Arnold event just finished and was a big success, largely due to the organizers, Kevin Buckland his wife Pertain Gillespie. They were given a round of applause.

The business meeting adjourned at 2:41 PM.

After a short break for refreshments, Charles Rowland began his watercolor demonstration. He gave a brief introduction to the Elements of Design (line, value, color, texture, shape, size, and direction) and the Principles of Design (unity, conflict, dominance, repetition with variation, alternation, balance, harmony, and gradation), as codified by Edgar Whitney. He then proceeded to demonstrate some of these ideas in a painting focused on a white house. Charlie's finished result was roundly applauded. (The final product can be seen on the Society's Facebook page.)


