- Recording Secretary Mitch Masters asked whether there were any corrections or additions to the October minutes. None were offered.

- **Lavone Sulwalski** (Hospitality Committee) had nothing new to report. She thanked the people who provided the evening's (excellent) refreshments.

• **Suzanne Accetta**, filling in for Sally Ford-Lyles, reported on the Fall Show, which will be from Nov. 19 to Dec. 18. Take-in is Thursday, Nov. 16, from 10 AM to noon at the German Village Meeting Haus, with jurying and picture hanging in the afternoon so that everything can be finished in one day. Suzanne asked for volunteers to help at the show and sent around a sign-up sheet. The opening reception will be Sunday, Nov. 19,
