President **Suzanne Accetta** opened the meeting at 6:32 p.m. **Sandy Gaunt** submitted a financial report to **SA** by email. Our checking account balance as of the end of the year was \$11,262.54. Our savings account balance was \$7,519.38. **Mitch Masters** asked if there were any changes or additions to the December minutes (January's meeting having been cancelled). There were none.

Announcements and Reports

- Sally Ford-Lyles noted that the Central Ohio Watercolor Society has been participating in the annual Haus und Garten tour for many years, with the result that the winning paintings bought by the German Village Society each year constitute a virtual history of our Society. The tour takes place during the last weekend in June each year. - Lavonne Suwalski and David Friedlander (co-chairs of the Hospitality/Social Committee) passed around a sign-up sheet for volunteers to bring refreshments to future meetings. If you missed the meeting but would like to volunteer, please email Lavonne at suwalski@verizon.net.
- Sally Ford-Lyles queried members about the Fall Show, seeking opinions on whom to invite to jury the show and hold a workshop, whether the workshop should be in conjunction with the show, and whether it should be 2, 3, or 4 days long. She will ask Fred Graff if he is able to jury the show and present a workshop. The workshop will be in conjunction with the Fall Show; its duration is still to be determined.
- The **Spring Show** will be held March 6 to April 7 at the Fort Hayes Shot Gallery. Takein is Monday Feb. 27 from 10 a.m. to noon. There will be a reception on Thursday, March 16, from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. Information and entry form for the Spring Show is on the COWS website under "News & Events."
