After a short break for refreshments, Christiane Curry began her watercolor demonstration. She has painted for almost all her life, but lately, for personal reasons, she has begun to paint almost exclusively on a small scale (paper size 5.5 x 7.5 inches, a size

that allows her to use standard 5×7 mats). Her approach is spontaneous and intuitive rather than carefully planned out ahead of time as is normally the case with large paintings. Her initial sketch consisted only of a horizontal line to indicate the horizon. Her first strokes were with a 1.5" flat brush. Christiane said that she takes many pictures with her smartphone, often from the car window, looking for interesting shapes and textures. However, once she starts a painting the reference photo (if she has one at all) becomes very much secondary to what is happening in front of her. During the approximately hour and a quarter of her demonstration Christiane completed two watercolors while still having plenty of time for commentary, discussion, and stories. Everyone greatly enjoyed her presentation.


