- Sandy Gaunt, Treasurer, reported that, as of October 31, the Society had a balance of \$9,656.95 in checking and of \$8,052.16 in savings, for a total of \$17,709.11. ### **Committee Reports**

- Pam Hartford and Sally Ford-Lyles (absent) reporting for the Website Committee said they plan to reorganize the website after the Fall Show. - Pam Harford, as chair of the Public Relations Committee, noted that our Society needs to develop
  a greater presence on social media, which seems to be the way most people these days find out
  about cultural events.
- **Linda Coe** and **Suzanne Accetta** reporting for the Scholarship Committee noted that some progress had been made in contacting art teachers. Teachers generally liked the idea of scholarships for students interested in watercolor and for teachers interested in attending watercolor workshops.
- Suzanne Accetta reported on arrangements for the Spring Show, which will be at the Ohio State
  University Faculty Club in May of next year. Drop-off arrangements will need to be developed,
  since access to campus is somewhat difficult. Suzanne has also contacted the Columbus Cultural
  Arts Center about hosting the 2021 Spring Show.
- Suzanne Accetta, as Program Committee Chair, has been soliciting speakers for future meetings. She reported that Bess Alexander has agreed to do a pouring demonstration at our February meeting, which generated considerable enthusiasm.

#### **Old Business**

• **Suzanne Accetta** reported that she has followed through on buying new equipment for future presentations, including an Epson projector, a small portable indoor/outdoor projection screen, and tripods to hold the projector and an iphone/ipad recording device.

### **New Business**

After some discussion, it was decided that the December meeting will include a White Elephant

that would be a plus. Members attending are also encouraged to bring a delicacy to share. (I vote
