
Columbus Arts Festival Demonstration

- The German Village Wet Paint competition is open to members of the Central Ohio Watercolor Society ONLY.
- On Wednesday, June 20th, we invite you to attend an informational meeting and draw numbers for the houses you will paint. You will then have the opportunity to visit the home. We will have 13-15 properties on tour this year.
- The day of the tour, artists must check in with Coordinator Terri Dickey at the Meeting Haus, 588 South Third Street by 8:15am.
- One watercolor painted during the tour by each artist will be delivered to the Meeting Haus and submitted for competition at 5:00pm.
- A juror will select the Blue Ribbon and Founders Award winning paintings. The Blue Ribbon will be awarded \$500 and the painting will be presented to the German Village Society for display in the Meeting Haus. The Founders Award and Art Patron Purchase winners will receive \$300 and the painting will go to the sponsors of each award gift. All other entries will be offered for sale to the guests who attend the 6:30pm volunteer party on the Platz. Proceeds from the Purchase Awards go to the artist.
- All selected artists must sign a copyright release granting the German Village Society ownership of the Blue Ribbon painting and the rights to the work.
- A box lunch will be provided on Tour day to participating artists.
