## 2012 NEW MEMBER INFORMATION for The CENTRAL OHIO WATERCOLOR SOCIETY

Candidates for membership in the Central Ohio Watercolor Society must be recommended by a current member. Once a year, the Society opens its membership to artists who are interested in furthering the use of transparent watercolor as an artistic expression. One of the requirements is that they are a resident of one of the following counties: Franklin, Delaware, Perry, Muskigham, Coschocton, Knox, Morrow, Marion, and Fayett counties.

Artists who wanted to further the interest in transparent watercolor founded the Central Ohio Watercolor Society in1965. The Society has grown through the years to approximately 135 members and includes some of the finest watercolor artists in central Ohio; many are nationally recognized.

This year the selection for new members will take place on Saturday, December 1, 2012 at the Westerville Library on State Street in Westerville Ohio. (Meeting Room A.)

Time for delivery of art is between 12:30 and 1:00 p.m. The work will be judged at this time. Pickup for artwork will be 2:00 p.m. sharp. Artists will be notified the following week by letter. The only medium that should be used is transparent watercolor on unaltered paper. The only white should be the white of the paper. Paintings should be matted with off white or plain white mats. Do not frame your work. PRINT your name and address and phone number on a label and place on left hand corner of the back of each painting.
