All artworks must be clean, in a sturdy frame, wired at back and ready to hang (NO saw tooth hangers, NO glass, **Plexiglas only**). White or cream mats only.

ALL ARTWORKS MUST BE FOR SALE. German Village's commission is **20%** of the sale price. No artwork to be removed before show ends NO EXCEPTIONS. Entry fee: \$15 per person, check made out to COWS, to submit up to three pieces for consideration. All submitted artworks will be juried in and judged for awards and ribbons. Drop off paintings, entry forms and \$15 check Wednesday, 10/31/12 from 10:00 am - 12:30 pm at German Village Meeting Haus, 588 South Third Street, Columbus. GOOD LUCK!
