Keys to Better Paintings

Charles Rowland Watercolor Workshop August 4, 2012 10:00-5:00

Award winning artist and teacher Charles Rowland will lead a one-day workshop at the Museum on August 4th. He will share the design fundamentals and techniques that allow his watercolors to capture the essence and emotion of the subject while involving the viewers' imagination in its interpretation.

The workshop will focus on some of the tools and techniques that can make a significant impact on the quality and "finished" appearance of a painting. Things like how edges are handled, working to make interesting shapes and mixing of color. The class will include instruction, demonstrations, painting time, and a group critique.

This class is being offered by CMA in partnership with the Central Ohio Watercolor Society. The cost for members of CMA and COWS is \$75, non-members \$85. Class size will be limited to 20 students.
